

Simple & Easy Transferring Photos To Pallets--Creative Craze #5

Items needed:

- Mod Podge Photo Transfer Medium
- Pallet Wood
- Laser print photo (Not inkjet) reversed and trimmed edges
- Foam Brush (to use mod podge)

Directions:

Step 1: Completely cover the printed side of the photo in mod podge until you can't see any of the photo.

Step 2: Immediately place picture on pallet with to coated side down on pallet. Press hard removing air bubbles as you place photo.

Step 3: Now let set for 24 hours so that it can cure. After 24 hours have passed, you can remove the paper. Begin by placing a wet cloth over the photo for 2 minutes.

Step 4: Begin rubbing the photo with damp towel in circular motions to remove paper. Be careful not to press to hard and remove part of the image. Continue until all the paper is removed.

Step 5: Congratulations! Now place your finished work for everyone to see.

Optional: You can use Matte Mod Podge to seal the image. You can do this step last.
